




A DECADE OF IMPACT: VITAL PAKISTAN TRUST'S JOURNEY

In 2013, Dr. Anita Zaidi, Former Chairperson, Department of Paediatric & Child Health, AKU won the inaugural \$1M Caplow Children's Prize - world's largest humanitarian award. She triumphed over 550 entries from all over the world, including those from major organizations. This led to the launch of VITAL Pakistan Trust.

Our journey began in Rehri Goth, a centuries-old fishing community on Karachi's outskirts, responding to staggering health statistics of 11% under-5 child mortality due to poverty and limited medical access. The neighborhood houses a multi-ethnic population of around 42,980 people.

Expanding from Rehri Goth, VITAL Pakistan Trust now operates in more than 45+ sites across Karachi, providing integrated healthcare services to mothers and children. Over the years, our impact has been significant: between 2013 and 2018, there was a remarkable 48% reduction in under-5 mortality and an impressive 53% decrease in neonatal mortality, signifying substantial progress in improving health indicators for this marginalized community.

As we continue to expand our footprint and make our impact upon the women and children who need it most, so do our services, our workforce, our patient base and the lives we save on a daily basis.

Our Services



Antenatal and Postnatal Care

Care during pregnancy which includes OPD visits, ultrasounds, screenings, delivery, postpartum care, and counselling.

Child OPD

Services include physical examinations, diagnosis, and treatment of illnesses, including growth and development assessments, and counselling.







Immunizations

Vaccines protect kids from 12 illnesses, such as TB, measles, mumps, rubella, polio, flu, typhoid, diarrhea, diphtheria, pertussis, tetanus, & hepatitis, at specific ages.



Malnutrition treatment typically involves dietary modifications, supplementation, and education on healthy eating habits.



Family Planning

Services include providing modern contraceptives (Short term and Long-term methods) and counselling services.

Sughra's Story

From Rehri Goth

Sughra, a resilient young woman was at a crossroad shaped by economic hardships. Sughra had an 8-year-old son, a 2-year-old daughter and was pregnant with her third child. Her husband did not support her, spending all the money he would earn, on alcohol consumption. Sughra had already faced the heart-wrenching decision to give up her second child due to the harsh grip of poverty. VITAL's commitment to fostering a community of care and understanding became a lifeline for Sughra. With proper counselling and family planning advice from the staff at VITAL, and an offer to work at the clinic as a helper. VITAL stood as a testament to the transformative impact of support systems on the lives of those facing the most challenging circumstances.


